(Delivery Redistribution of Produce and Surplus)

DROPS is a program of the Utah Food Bank that distributes donations including fresh produce, dairy products, and day-old bread to designated sites throughout the state of Utah.

Food Stamps are designed to improve the nutrition of people with low income. Those who meet the eligibility requirements are entitled to receive benefits to cover part of their household food budget. FOOD PANTRIES

Basic Requirements (Unless otherwise noted):

Photo I.D. for adults (18 and over), I.D. for children (social security card, medical record, birth certificate, etc.), and verification of address (utility bill, lease agreement, etc.).

* These pantries usually have emergency baby supplies on hand. Call ahead to check availability of supplies.
